

Information on the processing of personal data in "RUN FOR FUN ANYTIME!"

Data Controller:

The company under the name "**INTERAMERICAN HELLENIC INSURANCE S.A.**" (hereinafter referred to as the "**Company**") is the "Data Controller" in accordance with the General Regulation (EU) 2016/679 and the Protection of Natural Persons with regard to the Processing of Personal Data and the Free Movement of such Data Law of 2018 (Law 125(I)/2018). The Company is an insurance company operating in Greece, is based in Athens at 124-126 Syngrou Avenue, P.C. 117 45, has received a registration number with the General Commercial Registry 000914001000, is registered in the Republic of Cyprus as a foreign company with registration number AE 3036, having its registered office at 42-44 Griva Digeni Avenue, 1080 Nicosia, Cyprus and operates through the direct sales channel **ANYTIME**.

1. Purposes of processing

We will keep a record of your data and process it for the following purposes:

- (1) To communicate with you for your participation in the sports activities that will be organized in cities of Cyprus and any relevant training sessions.
- (2) Your assessment and inclusion in the right action team, depending on your age and fitness level.
- 3) The organization of your participation for the smooth conduct of sports training and activities
- d) The legal promotion of the Company on <https://www.anytimeonline.com.cy/> corporate website and possibly on social media and the press.

In this context, the Company, using the communication methods you have declared, will send you updates regarding the above purposes

If you want us to stop sending you such updates, each time you receive an immediate notification, we will also let you know how you can easily withdraw your consent. Notwithstanding this possibility, you can object at any time to the processing of your data for the above purposes by sending a relevant request to the INTERAMERICAN Data Protection Officer at the email dpo@anytimeonline.com.cy and your data will no longer be processed.

1. Legal basis

We will process your data based on the following legal bases: (a) your explicit consent that we receive after informing you, (b) the legitimate interest of our company to properly organize the aforementioned events and actions and to defend its legitimate interests.

2. Data categories

We will process the following categories of data:

- (a) contact details of you that you would provide to us: e-mail address, telephone number,
- (b) information about you: name, fitness level, age
- (c) Photographic material or video that will be collected from the mass participation in sports activities and will aim at the legal promotion of the action and the organizing Company through general image shots and will not focus specifically on the faces of the participants.

3. Categories of data subjects

We will process the personal data of natural persons who participate in the training activities

4. Retention period

We will keep your data for as long as you participate in training and sports activities in electronic form and until 1 month later, a period of time deemed reasonable for the purpose for which we collected it. After this period of time, your data will be deleted from our Records.

5. Recipients

Your data will be processed, if necessary, by authorized employees of various departments of our company.

6. Transfers outside the EU

Your data will not be transferred outside the EU

7. Automated decision making

There is no automated decision making for the above purposes of processing

8. Technical and Organizational Measures

We would like to assure you that we apply all modern and appropriate technical and organizational measures for the purposes of the processing, the response of which we check at regular intervals in order to:

1. To protect your personal data from unauthorized access and improper use.
2. To secure our IT systems and protect information.
3. Indicative measures that support both the physical and electronic security of the data processed are the physical presence of security in our buildings, the installation of a closed circuit monitoring of the critical areas for us, the implementation of a Proper Use of Resources Policy, Security Policy and supporting procedures, the installation of a firewall, antivirus software, antimalware), the implementation of a data leak prevention system (DLP), the use of 2-factor authentication (2 Factor Authentication), case-by-case encryption and more.

4. Rights you have in relation to the processing of your data

You have the following rights set out in the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR, Regulation (EU) 2016/679):

- (1) the right of access to find out what data we are processing about you, why and their recipients as well as to receive copies of the data kept in our Company.
- (2) the right to rectification to request that any inaccuracies or inaccuracies in your data be corrected;
- (3) the right to restrict the processing of your data
- (4) the right to erasure to request the deletion of your personal data from the Company's records, if you no longer wish these data to be processed, and if there is no legitimate reason for our Company to hold and process them as Data Controller.

(5) the right to object by which you can object at any time to the processing of your personal data by withdrawing your consent.

If you exercise any of these rights by sending a written request to the Company's Data Protection Officer at email dpo@anytimeonline.com.cy or helpdesk@anytimeonline.com.cy, we will take every possible measure to satisfy your request within thirty (30) days from the receipt of the relevant request.
